Project Description

The Englewood Family Practice relocated to the second floor of the Good Samaritan North Health Center in Englewood, OH. Tri-Tech worked with the owner and architectural design team to coordinate space layouts and utility requirements for the renovated spaces.

The tenant space provided for 15 Exam Rooms, a centralized Nurse Station and support program spaces. various particular importance was for the Nurse Station to be designed in a manner that allowed for proper interface between the PA. MA and MCR teams. The final design of the space allowed for 10 representatives of the medical team plus an area for informal group meetings, along with a more open and patient welcoming design of the registration/check-out.

Plumbing work in the space included removal of existing fixtures and piping and replacement with new fixtures, along with extending existing systems to additional new locations. Mechanical work included removal of existing branch distribution and devices, and creation of new zoning with extension from the existing air distribution system. Electrical work required replacement of existing lighting with new LED lighting, along with coordination with the existing electrical distribution to accommodate new equipment and power layout requirements
